The deadline for voter registration for the May 2, 2017 Primary Election is Monday April 3, 2017. You may register by mail or in person at the following agencies or offices during their normal hours of operation: Jackson County Board of Elections, Ohio Secretary of State, Public Libraries, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, public high schools, vocational schools, Department of Health, Department of Human Services, Department of Mental Health, Department of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, or Rehabilitation Services Commission. You may update your address or register online by going to Jackson Co Board of Elections website at <http://www.electionsonthe.net/oh/jackson/> once there click on the Registration Information tab, click on "Online Change of Address", "Register to Vote" or "Voter Registration Form" to print & mail or hand deliver your form to our office at 275 Portsmouth St., Suite 2 Jackson, Oh 45640.

The Jackson County Board of Elections will conduct extended office hours for voter registration on Monday April 3, 2017. The office will be open from 8:00 A.M. until 9:00 P.M. All new voter registrations, address and or name changes **must be received or postmarked** by April 3, 2017 to be eligible to vote in the May 2, 2017 Primary Election.

To qualify to vote, you must be: a citizen of the United States; 18 years old on or before May 2, 2017; a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before Election Day; registered to vote at least 30 days before Election Day.

Early in person voting will begin Tuesday April 4, 2017 and will be conducted at the Jackson Co Board of Elections office at 275 Portsmouth St, Suite 2, Jackson, Ohio 45640. The hours for voting are:

8:00am-5:00pm Tuesday April 4- Friday April 7;

8:00am-5:00pm Monday- Friday April 10- April 14;

8:00am-5:00pm Monday-Friday April 17-April 21;

8:00am-7:00pm Monday-Friday April 24-April 28;

8:00am-4:00pm Saturday April 29

1:00pm-5:00pm Sunday April 30

The final day to vote early will begin at 8:00am and end at 2:00pm Monday May 1

Absentee ballots will begin being mailed out on April 4, 2017. Absentee ballots may be returned to the Board Office in person until Tuesday May 2nd at 7:30pm. If they are mailed back they must be postmarked by the Post Office by midnight May 1, 2017.
