VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

The close of voter registration for the November 7, 2017 General Election will be Tuesday, October 10th, 2017 at 9:00 p.m. The Madison County Board of Election's office will be open from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. on October 10th, 2017.

Those submitting voter registration forms by mail in order to be eligible to vote in the November 7, 2017 General Election must have the envelope postmarked by October 10th, 2017.

To be eligible to vote, individuals must be:

- ✓ Native or naturalized citizen of the United States
- ✓ A resident of Ohio 30 days immediately prior to the date of the election
- ✓ A resident of Madison County, Ohio
- ✓ At least 18 years of age (although an individual who will be 18 years old on or before the day of the next General Election may register to vote in the partisan Primary Election immediately preceding that General Election)

Registration forms are available at all public libraries throughout Madison County and the state of Ohio, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, the Madison County Treasurer's office, and all other Human Service agencies.

Voters may also register to vote at the Board of Election's office, located at 1423 State Route 38 SE, in London, Ohio, 43140 or may call 740-852-9424 and request a registration form be mailed. Normal Board of Election's office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

You may register or update your voter registration using the website at www.myohiovote.com.

Those previously registered in Madison County **do not need** to re-register unless the address or name of the voter has changed. Any changes (name change or address change) to a voter's registration must be made by the deadline of October 10th, 2017 and may be made by submitting a completed voter registration form.
